3 2023/24 Student Grant

A one-off student grant of \$2,500 for each secondary day-school, primary school and kindergarten student was provided in the 2019/20 school year to alleviate parents' financial burden and defray education expenses. The provision was approved by the Finance Committee of the Legislative Council on 6th December 2019. According to the Chief Executive's 2019 Policy Address, the provision of the student grant has been regularised starting from the 2020/21 school year.

The student grant is 'non-means tested'. All students, as at the date of application, studying in secondary day-schools are eligible for the grant. Students of evening schools, students of private studies, holders of student visas for entry into Hong Kong for studies, and holders of Recognizance Forms issued by the Immigration Department, are not within the scope of the subsidy.

Starting from the 2023/24 school year, the EDB will introduce electronic submission of student grant applications (e-submission) in public sector schools and DSS schools. To cater for the needs of individual parents, as an alternative to making an e-submission, parents can still choose to return the completed paper application form to schools. However, only one application, either in electronic form (e-form) or paper form, can be submitted for each eligible student.

3.1 E-submission

Applicants must have a user account of "iAM Smart+" with digital signing function. They may log in to the online service of "e-Submission of Student Grant Applications" via the "iAM Smart" App directly.
