'Global Classroom Programme: Citizenship and Social Development –Shanxi Study Tour'
(Applicable to S.4 and S.5)

1. Objective:
The first domestic "3A game" "Black Myth: Wukong" was filmed at various locations in Shanxi Province, making "Shanxi tourism" a hot search topic. This study tour will focus on the filming locations of "Black Myth: Wukong" as a main theme, leading students to observe traditional Chinese architecture and experience traditional culture in Shanxi. This will allow students to deeply appreciate the cultural heritage of our country, build cultural confidence, and at the same time, take pride in the achievements of the motherland in different fields such as economy, cultural innovation, and conservation, thereby strengthening students' national identity.
2. Connection between the study content and the curriculum:
 - 2.1 History and Culture: Shanxi is the province with the most existing ancient architecture in our country. The Ancient City of Pingyao, Mount Wutai, and the Yungang Grottoes are listed as World Cultural Heritage sites. Through the study tour, students can understand the country's cultural undertakings and appreciate the uniqueness, continuity, diversity, and inclusiveness of Chinese culture.
 - 2.2 Comprehensive National Power: "Black Myth: Wukong" is based on "Journey to the West". By observing cultural relics, students can gain a deeper understanding of Chinese myths, legends, figures, and ancient architecture. Interacting with local people and travelers will help students experience the strength of our country's cultural innovation technology and its international impact.
 - 2.3 Sustainable Development: Our country ranks first in the world in coal resource production, but the use of fossil energy brings environmental issues. By visiting the Coal Museum, students can understand the energy industry in our country, reflect on how to balance economic development and environmental conservation, and understand the necessity of developing clean energy.
3. Date: 18th April (Fri) to 25th April (Fri) (8 days 7 nights)
4. Target: S.4 to S.5 students
5. Quota: 16-20 students
6. Organizing Agency: HKFEW International Culture Exchange Centre
7. Fee and Subsidy Amount:
 - 7.1 The fee for each participant is \$850 (original price is \$7,698, subsidized by Citizen and Social Development at \$3,848, the Life-wide Learning Fund at \$1,500 and the Feed-in Tariff Fund at \$1,500 per participant, refer to the remark in point 12 for subsidy conditions);
 - 7.2 Tour fee, accommodation, transportation fee and insurance are included, but visa fee and personal consumption are excluded;
 - 7.3 If students are absent without proper reason, all payments will be non-refundable, and the student will be required to reimburse the school-supported amount of \$6,848.

18/4 (Fri) HK>>Shengzhen>> Taiyuan	Gather at the ELCHK Truth Lutheran Church in the morning, take a direct coach to Shenzhen Bao'an International Airport, and board a flight to Shanxi Taiyuan International Airport. Arrive in Taiyuan in the afternoon Visit Liuxiang Pedestrian Street, Clock Tower Street, and Food Street
19/4 (Sat)	Visit Yanmenguan Pass (including electric car), Yungang Grottoes (including electric car)
20/4 (Sun)	Visit Hanging Temple (including ticket for ascension), Yingxian Wooden Pagoda
21/4 (Mon)	Tour Mount Wutai Scenic Area and visit Coal Museum
22/4 (Tue)	Explore Pingyao Ancient City (including electric car and all-inclusive ticket for touring city walls, county government office, security bureau, Rishengchang, etc.), Shuanglin Temple, Wang Family Courtyard. Experience Activity: Intangible Cultural Heritage Handicraft - Pingyao Paper Cutting

23/4 (Wed)	Visit Xiaoxitian, Hukou Waterfall (includes electric car)
24/4 (Thu)	Visit Yuhuang Temple in Fucheng (Twenty-Eight Mansions), Iron Buddha Temple, Guanyin Hall, Situxiaozhen Town and watch Da Tiehua
25/4 (Fri) Zhengzhou>> Shenzhen>> HK	The afternoon flight returns from Zhengzhou (Zhengzhou Xinzheng International Airport) to Shenzhen, and then transfers to a coach to Hong Kong.

10. Application arrangements:

10.1 Interested students should complete and return the reply slip to the class teacher on or before 21st January (Tue) (e-notice or paper-based notice);

10.2 Applicants must ensure they have valid documents (e.g. Home Return Permit) with a validity of at least 6 months before departure;

10.3 If the number of applicants exceeds the quota, a selection process will be conducted. Participants will receive a "Selection Worksheet" and must submit it to the teacher in-charge by the specified date;

10.4 The list of selected participants will be announced on the Current Affairs Society's bulletin board.;

10.5 Successful applicants will receive a student registration form and student health declaration form on or before 24th January (Fri). They must submit the completed forms along with the fee (cheque payable to "The Incorporated Management Committee of ELCHK Lutheran Secondary School" or cash) to the General Office.

10.6 The application form should be submitted along with photocopies of the Hong Kong Identity Card and Home Return Permit (valid for at least six months), photocopied together on an A4 paper. If the Home Return Permit has expired, the student needs to renew it as soon as possible, which takes approximately two weeks for the renewal process
