Global Classroom Programme: Citizenship and Social Development – Hangzhou-Yiwu-Hengdian: A Journey of Technological Innovation and Cultural Creativity (Applicable to S.4-S.5)

1. Objective: Through on-site explorations and practical activities, we aim to help students gain a deep understanding of the practical applications of technological innovation and commercial & cultural creativity. They will also personally experience the modern development of Chinese cities, and enhance their sense of national identity.
2. Connection between Programme content and the Curriculum:
 - 2.1 Economic Globalisation: Yiwu, as the global small commodities trade centre, reflects China's central role in the global supply chain. Students can learn how China has become a world factory and trade power through innovation and diligence, further recognising the country's economic achievements.
 - 2.2 Technological Innovation: Hangzhou, as one of China's technological centres, allows students to visit the Robot Town and Geely Auto Factory, understand the latest developments in technologies such as AI, automation, and smart manufacturing, and see our country's independent R&D capability and global competitiveness in high-tech fields.
 - 2.3 Cultural Innovation: Hengdian World Studios epitomizes China's cultural and creative industry. By engaging with cultural and creative products and film and TV works, students can gain a deeper understanding of the integration of traditional Chinese culture with modern creativity, thus enhancing cultural confidence.
3. Date: 7th July (Mon) to 11th July (Fri) (5 days 4 nights)
4. Target : S.4 to S.5 students
5. Quota: : 16 students
6. Organizing Agency : Council for International Culture Exchange
7. Fee and Subsidy Amount:
 - 7.1 The fee for each participant is \$3,300 (original price is \$5,990, subsidized by Citizen and Social Development at \$2,690) (Life-wide Learning Fund – Students who are supported by the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) Scheme or have obtained aid through the School Textbook Assistance (TA) Scheme (Full/ Half Grant) will receive a maximum of \$1,500. Upon enrolment confirmation, the subsidy will be automatically applied, reducing the payable amount to HK\$1,800.);
 - 7.2 Tour fee, accommodation, transportation fee and insurance are included, but visa fee and personal consumption are excluded;
 - 7.3 If students are absent without proper reason, all payments will be non-refundable, and the student will be required to reimburse the school-supported amount of \$2,690 (For applicants approved for the Life-wide Learning Fund, the payment will be \$4,190).

 - 10.1 Interested students should complete and return the reply slip to the class teacher on or before 7th April (Mon) (e-notice or paper-based notice);
 - 10.2 Applicants must ensure they have valid documents (e.g., Home Return Permit) with a validity of at least 6 months before departure;
 - 10.3 If the number of applicants exceeds the quota, a selection process will be conducted. Participants will receive a "Selection Worksheet" and must submit it to the responsible teacher by the specified date. Late submissions will be treated as automatic withdrawal from the selection process;
 - 10.4 The list of accepted participants will be announced on the Current Affairs Society's bulletin board;
 - 10.5 Successful applicants will receive a student registration form and student health declaration form on or before 14th April (Mon). They must submit the completed forms along with the fee (cheque payable to "The Incorporated Management Committee of ELCHK Lutheran Secondary School" or cash) to the General Office;
 - 10.6 The application form should be submitted along with photocopies of the Hong Kong Identity Card and Home Return Permit or other valid travel documents (valid for at least six months), photocopied together on an A4 paper. If the Home Return Permit or other valid travel documents has expired, the student needs to renew it as soon as possible, which takes approximately two weeks for the renewal process.
