2. Online Reading Scheme for Chinese History - "Fireflies" Programme (Applicable to S.1-S.3)

This year, the Chinese History Department has arranged for S.1-S.3 students to participate in The Academy of Chinese Studies-"Fireflies Online Reading Scheme". The aims are to cultivate students' interest in reading and to enrich their knowledge related to Chinese history and culture. This scheme is free of charge. Starting from 6th October 2025 (Mon), and continuing until the end of May 2026, students are required to log in to the following website every Monday to Friday to read a designated history/culture passage and answer simple questions. The scheme includes a catch-up mechanism. Points from answering questions are cumulative and will be used to assess the certificate awarded at the end of the term. Relevant login information has been distributed to students by their respective Chinese History teachers. Instructions regarding the website interface and operation methods have been explained in Chinese History lessons and uploaded to Google Classroom. We kindly request your support in encouraging and supervising your child to complete the daily online reading and exercises on time.

S.6 School Nominations Direct Admission Scheme

The eight UGC-funded universities have designated a total of around 300 publicly-funded undergraduate programmes to participate in SNDAS. For the specific admission requirements for each programme, please visit the following website or scan the QR code on the right:

1. Quota:

Each local secondary school has a quota of **TWO nominations** for nominating students with exceptional talents and interests in specific disciplines / areas. Each student nominee can apply for admission to **ONE** designated UGC-funded undergraduate programme participating in SNDAS.

2. Procedures:

Students may in person submit the completed ‘application form of Principal’s Recommendation Scheme JUPAS (CGC_form_001)’ and copies of relevant supporting documents to Mr. Ho Cho Ming (Rm511) on or before 5th November (Wed). (You may collect the application form at the School Office.)

3. Interview:

Interviews will be arranged between 10th November (Mon) and 19th November (Wed). The results will be posted on the Careers Committee Bulletin Board near the Principal’s Office on or before 25th November (Tue).

4. Remarks:

- 4.1 Given that the SNDAS will be implemented in parallel with the JUPAS route, students nominated for SNDAS should submit their JUPAS application at the same time. Student nominees **CANNOT** simultaneously apply for admission to universities via the **School Principal’s Nominations Scheme (SPN) under JUPAS** or the respective direct admission schemes for prospective student-athletes established by the eight University Grants Committee (UGC)-funded universities under the UGC’s **Student-Athlete Learning Support and Admission Scheme**.
- 4.2 Student nominees **MUST** include the chosen SNDAS-participating undergraduate programme as one of their 20 JUPAS programme choices; student nominees who fail to do so will not be considered by the participating universities for SNDAS.
- 4.3 Participating universities may also require student nominees to include their chosen SNDAS-participating programme as one of their JUPAS Band A programme choices. Please study the specific admission requirements for each participating programme.
- 4.4 Participating universities will arrange interviews for **ALL** students nominated for SNDAS to assess the suitability of the nominees for specific programmes between January and early June 2026. Written / practical assessments may also be arranged.
- 4.5 Participating universities will make firm offers to successful SNDAS student nominees in June 2026, prior to the release of the 2026 HKDSE Examination results.
- 4.6 Successful nominees **MUST** decide whether to accept the offer **BEFORE** the release of the 2026 HKDSE Examination results. Once accepted, the firm offer will be binding and the nominees **WILL NOT** be considered / accepted by other programmes regardless of their HKDSE Examination results. Their JUPAS application will automatically be removed from the JUPAS application system. Successful nominees who have accepted the firm offer will commence study for their chosen programme in September 2026.
- 4.7 For unsuccessful nominees (i.e. those who did not receive / rejected the SNDAS offer), their JUPAS applications will continue to be processed and be considered by the JUPAS-participating institutions for admission to their programmes following the release of the 2026 HKDSE Examination results.
