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Dear Parents,

1 **The Eighth Batch of Child Development Fund (CDF) School-based Projects** (Applicable to S1)

To support students to pursue their dreams, our School has joined the "Eighth Batch of Child Development Fund (CDF) School-based Projects", which is held by the Social Welfare Department.

Introduction	Through formulating and implementing the personal development plans, the three-year project aims to encourage students to develop an asset-building habit as well as accumulate savings and intangible qualities (such as positive attitude, personal resilience and capacities, social networks etc.) which are important qualities for their future development.
Participant	Students from S1 to S3 who meet the Eligibility Criterion (S2 and S3 students don't need to reply again as they have been informed through previous notices.)
Quota	80 students (S1 to S3)
Requirements	Students whose family is either earning a household income less than 75% of the median monthly domestic household income; or receiving financial assistance including: (1) the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance; (2) the Working Family Allowance; or (3) full grants from student finance schemes administered by the Student Finance Office.
Procedures	Interested students need to submit relevant documents which will be reviewed; and they may be replied to individually for further information. Please contact the project operators for enquiries about application.
Key Components	(1) <u>Targeted Savings</u> Students are encouraged to set a monthly savings target of HK\$200 over a two-year period, saving HK\$4,800 in total. Corporate and/or private donors, together with the Government, contribute to a 1:1:1 matching fund for the savings. Each student can achieve up to a maximum sum of HK\$14,400 (200 x 24 x 3 HKD) to implement their Personal Development Plans in the third year upon completion of the Targeted Savings Programme. The operator, CityLab, will register a bank account to manage the savings from all participants, matched donations, and rewards.
	(2) <u>Mentorship</u> Every CDF student will be matched with a volunteer mentor to obtain support throughout the three-year programme. As a Life Guide, a mentor is expected to widen the participant's horizons, offer career inspirations, and assist in building up self-esteem and resilience, providing guidance and companionship as part of the personal development experience. They will keep in contact with the mentee at least once per month, sharing life experiences, and providing guidance, support, and encouragement.
	(3) <u>Personal Development</u> In the first year of the project, students draw up their Personal Development Plan (PDP). From the middle of the second year, the plan should be implemented under the guidance of the School, operators and mentors. The training courses will be provided to involve self-recognition, personal development, financial management, and so on. The purpose is to help the students plan their personal development and encourage them to participate in social services. The plan should include both short-term and long-term development goals, with specific action steps that set them on the path to attainment. The development goals should support capacity enhancement, developing knowledge or skills around a particular hobby/interest, or to lay the foundation for further education or future career. In the third year of the project, CDF participants can make use of the targeted savings to implement their PDPs and the CDF project operators will monitor their progress of implementation.
