1 **S3 Senior Secondary Subject Opinion Collection**

The School has arranged three categories of subjects. They are DSE elective subjects (Category A); applied learning subjects (Category B) and other language subjects (Category C). In order to provide a suitable medium of instruction and appropriate elective subjects to your child for their senior secondary study, our School has arranged for S3 students (S4 in 2022-2023) to complete the subject opinion survey. This will enable the School to provide a clear bridge between the junior and senior syllabus with explicit curriculum links between the two. Our goal is for your child to have adequate time to prepare for their senior secondary studies and master the examination skills necessary to achieve excellent results. In completing the survey form (distributed by class teachers), please consider your child's Chinese and English ability, academic results (e.g. the Unified Assessment of the first semester) and learning interests. The completed form should be returned to the class teacher on or before 25th November (Thu) for collection. After taking into consideration each student's English ability, academic results in relevant subjects and the number of enrolments, the School will make the most appropriate and optimal arrangements. 3 **S2 Emotional Well-being Questionnaire - Anxiety and Depression**

Student Mental Health Support Scheme
Annual School-based Screening

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Food and Health Bureau in collaboration with the Hospital Authority, the Education Bureau and the Social Welfare Department has launched the “Student Mental Health Support Scheme” (Scheme) - initiated in the school year of 2016/17. Under this Scheme, an appointed Psychiatric Nurse and Assistant Social Work Officer (ASWO) of the Hospital Authority will work with schools to conduct an annual screening for the early identification and support of students with symptoms of anxiety and depressive mood. Our services include educational talks, group work, case assessment and consultation, all of which aim to enhance student mental health and personal growth.

According to overseas experience, early intervention can reduce youths’ anxiety symptoms and may improve their relationships with peers, parents and teachers, as well as academic performance. Thus, many schools in developed countries have implemented early identification and intervention programs that target anxiety issues.

Details of the annual school-based screening:

- Stage 1: Students fill out a questionnaire that measures anxiety symptoms
- Stage 2: School personnel contacts parents to arrange further assessment for students who exhibit anxiety symptoms based on the screening results
- Stage 3: Psychiatric Nurse provides relevant service to students with anxiety symptoms, e.g., Anxiety management group or individual follow-up


The Psychiatric Nurse will invite students or parents to fill out a questionnaire in November. Information collected will be used for assessment, research and educational purposes only. Personal data will be kept strictly confidential. If necessary, we may invite students or parents to fill out supplementary questionnaires for further assessment.
