2.2 Procedures:

- 2.2.2 Donations can be paid in cash, and a receipt can be obtained for donations of HK\$100 or more.
- 2.2.3 The donations are purely voluntary and no limit has been placed on the amount.

3 The Eighth Batch of Child Development Fund Programme

To support students in planning for their future, developing a habit of prudence in saving money and the accumulation of other desirable intangible assets, our School has joined the "Eighth Batch of Child Development Fund (CDF) Programme", in cooperation with CityLab. The School has invited students to participate in the scheme. The project is expected to be launched in December.

Throughout the three-year CDF programme, we aim to assist students by matching them with different funds (HK\$4,800 for each student) according to respective criteria. Thus, we have initiated this activity in the hope that it will have the whole-hearted support of parents. Details are as follows:

3.1 Important Information:

- The programme aims at helping low-income families, and families in need - as determined by specified financial criteria.
- HK\$4,800 can help a student from a low-income family to participate in this meaningful three-year programme.
- Administrative expenses will not be deducted from the donation, with the full amount being allocated to students participating in the programme.

3.2 Donation procedures:

- 3.2.1 Donations can be paid in cash or cheque. The cheque is payable to "幸福實驗室有限公司" (CityLab Limited). Write the name and phone number of the donor on the back of the cheque, and indicate the CDF donation. If you donate HK\$100 or more, you may receive a receipt for tax purposes.

5 **S1 to S5 First Term Exam, S6 Mock Exam Arrangements**

The First Term Exam will take place from 5th January to 17th January (S1 to S3) and from 4th January to 17th January (S4 to S5). S6 Mock Exam will take place from 18th January to 15th February. Details of the examination arrangements are shown in Attachment 3 to Attachment 6. Please encourage your child to be well-prepared in order to obtain the best results. Furthermore, please pay attention to the following items:

- 5.1 Students are required to tap their student ID cards before 8 a.m., otherwise they will be considered late.
- 5.2 Students must go directly to the examination rooms once they arrive at school for quiet revision. They must keep silent while waiting for the examination to commence.
- 5.3 In the event that any student has forgotten to bring their student ID card, that student needs to bring his/her student handbook to Room 207 to verify his/her identity. Under these circumstances, the exam WILL NOT be delayed and the student will not be given extra time for the exam.
- 5.4 Regarding absence or lateness without reason; 0 marks may be given for that subject.
- 5.5 Before the commencement of an examination, students are reminded to take the battery from their mobile phones (if possible) to ensure that no sound will be emitted. The alarm function of the mobile phone or any devices with an alarm function (including electronic watches) should not be in stand-by mode. You may be subject to a penalty according to the school regulations if your mobile phone or the alarm rings during an examination.
- 5.6 If the child cannot attend an exam because of illness or any special reasons, the parent must apply for leave to the School by phone call on that morning. Only after the student carries out the leave application procedures upon his/her return to school (and presentation of a medical certificate for sick leave to Mr. Ko, the Vice Dean of Studies, at Room 301), will special arrangements for the exam be considered.
- 5.7 Special arrangements for the absence will be considered only if the student approaches Mr. Ko at Room 301 by 14th December.
- 5.8 If the Education Bureau announces suspension of classes because of adverse weather conditions, all the exams scheduled for that day will be rearranged. Please visit the School website: <http://www.lss.edu.hk> for detailed information of arrangements.

5.9 If a student is absent from the lessons of a particular subject for over one-eighth of the total lessons (including sick leave and casual leave) in each term, s/he will not be allowed to attend the exam and 0 marks will be given for that subject (except for students who receive exemption approval from the Principal in advance).

5.10 Please refer to P.15-16 of the student handbook for other exam regulations.

5.11 Promotion requirements

5.11.1 S1 to S3 students will not be allowed to be promoted if they cannot achieve a pass in the overall results of Chinese, English and Maths; or their Conduct has been determined to be unsatisfactory.

5.11.2 S4 to S6 students will not be allowed to be promoted if they cannot achieve a pass in the overall results of Chinese, English, Maths, Citizenship and Social Development and Liberal Studies; or their Conduct has been determined to be unsatisfactory.

During the first term examinations, the classrooms will be used as different exam venues. S1 to S6 students need to take all of their textbooks, exercise books, notes etc. home for the purposes of revision before 21st December, 2021 (Tue). In case any personal belongings are found in the examination venues, they will be passed to their class teachers. 
