5 Love Foundation "Blessings of the Epidemic, Whole Person Care" 3.0

Due to the prevailing situation of the epidemic, many families are facing unemployment and the subsequent impact on their livelihoods. Our School has been invited to apply for the Love Foundation "Blessings of the Epidemic, Whole Person Care" campaign - which hopes to provide financial assistance to the families of students who are unemployed or underemployed during the epidemic. Furthermore, the programme entitled "Love Foundation Extraordinary Youth 5G" is launched which aims at organizing activities for student beneficiaries to improve self-confidence, develop interpersonal skills, and instill in themselves the spirit of community service. Details are as follows:

5.1 Criteria:

- 5.1.1 Students who are studying at our School; and
- 5.1.2 Under the epidemic, the parents or guardians of the students who are unemployed or underemployed; and
- 5.1.3 The student has been approved by the Student Financial Assistance Agency for "full/half subsidy" for the current academic year.

5.2 Details:

- 5.2.1 Application quota: no more than 20 applicants per school;
- 5.2.2 Amount of subsidy: HK\$3,000 per family;
- 5.2.3 Deadline: Return the paper reply slip and Attachment 3 to the school office for collection before 2nd March, at which time parents can complete the reply slip and Attachment 3 at the school office if necessary.
- 5.2.4 The Careers Committee will notify the successful applicants individually after verifying the relevant application information.

5.3 "Love Foundation Extraordinary Youth 5G":

5.3.1 Details:

- 5.3.1.1 Applicants who are student beneficiaries do not need to pay.
- 5.3.1.2 To encourage students' active participation in this activity, if his/her attendance rates reaches 80% or above, a certificate and book allowance of HK\$1,000 will be offered.
- 5.3.1.3 Photographs/videos of recipients and activities may be published on the Love Foundation website and social media platforms to promote a culture of caring and love in the community.


